1. No purchase necessary. MAKING A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. Void where prohibited or restricted by law. All federal, state, and local regulations apply. The Contest is sponsored by KS1075 (the "Station") and Big City Burrito, Jarritos/Novamex ("Sponsors").
2. **HOW TO ENTER:** Registration period begins on Friday, February 26, 2010 and ends at approximately 11:59pm (MT) Wednesday, March 31, 2010. Log on to the KS1075 website at [www.ks1075.com](http://www.ks1075.com) and click the contest link for the "Crack the Safe Contest." Participants must be KS1075 VIP Club Members prior to participation. To join the KS1075 VIP Club, participants may log onto [www.ks1075.com](http://www.ks1075.com), complete the official online free registration form with their name, address, phone number, date of birth and a valid email address. Participants will then play a game of "hi-lo" to guess the four-digit combination of the contest safe. Once the participant correctly guesses the four-digit combination of the contest safe, the participant will then complete the official online registration form with their name, address, phone number, and a valid email address. Only one entry per person during the duration of this contest will be permitted. All entries submitted become the sole property of the Station and will not be acknowledged or returned. Station has the right to delete any entry knowingly received from persons under the age of 13 in compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act or any entry containing profane or objectionable subject matter or images. Only one Internet entry per person and one Internet entry per email address is permitted. Internet entries will be deemed made by the authorized account holder of the email address submitted at the time of entry. The authorized account holder is the natural person who is assigned to the email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization that is responsible by assigning email address or the domain associated with the submitted email address. Multiple participants are not permitted to share the same email address. All entries submitted become the sole property of the Station and will not be acknowledged or returned. Use of any device to automate entry is prohibited. Proof of submission of an entry shall not be deemed proof of receipt by the Station. The Station's computer is the official time keeping device for the Contest. All entries must be received by 11:59pm (MT) Wednesday, March 31, 2010. The Station assumes no responsibility for entries not received.
3. **WINNER SELECTION:** Then on or around Thursday, April 1, 2010, the staff of KS1075 will randomly draw (30) thirty people from all eligible entries to win one (1) of thirty (30) runner-up prizes and one (1) winner will be selected from all eligible entries Grand Prize. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.
4. **PRIZES:** Thirty (30) Runner-Up Winners will be awarded the following Prize:

One (1) trip for two adults to Cancun, Mexico. The trip winner must be 21 or over at the time of winning. Travel dates are as follows anytime between **November 1 – 20, 2010**. No date exchanges or extensions will be provided. The trip will include the following:

Married or divorced women traveling under names other than what is printed on their travel documents, must supply a marriage license and/or divorce decree. KS1075 will not rebook or revise any reservations if travelers do not possess a valid U.S. Passport by their date of departure. Travel arrangements are subject to availability. Grand Prize Winner and their travel guest will be required to sign the eligibility and release form. All other expenses not specifically mentioned herein are solely the responsibility of the Grand Prize Winner and his or her travel guest. All travel must be taken on the dates specified; no alternative travel dates are available. All travel is subject to availability and restrictions. years of age or older at the time of entry. **The trip winner must be 21 or over at the time of winning.** Employees of the Station, Lincoln Financial Media Company of Colorado, Lincoln National Corporation, Lincoln Financial Media Company, Big City Burrito, Jarritos/Novamex, their parent, subsidiary, and affiliated companies, and their advertising or promotional agencies (collectively, the "Contest Entities"), and the immediate families or members of the same households of such individuals are not eligible. This Contest is not open to other Denver metro Radio/TV station employees, and their immediate families, agencies and representatives. The term "immediate family members" include spouses, grandparents, parents, siblings, children and grandchildren. No groups, clubs, or organizations may participate in this Contest or reproduce or distribute any portion of these rules to their members. Proof of age, identity, and eligibility must be furnished to the Station upon request. All entry form information must be complete and accurate. The Station will not award a prize to anyone not meeting eligibility requirements at the time of entry. Entrants are required to provide truthful information and the Station will reject and delete any entry that it discovers to be false or fraudulent. The Station will disqualify any entry from individuals who do not meet the eligibility requirements, and the Station will also delete any entry knowingly received from persons under the age of 13 in compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act. The Station reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if these Contest rules are not followed. Military Exemption Clause: In the case of Active Military (United States Armed Forces) employees, who are based in Colorado but do not claim Colorado as their official residence on their Federal/State IRS Tax Forms are exempt from the Colorado Residency clause.
